
150th Anniversary Sail Past Saturday 25th June 2016

Directions

- The Sail Past will start at 12 noon from the Sail Past Committee Boat displaying a black flag moored to the south of the RUYC No. 1 racing mark, which itself is to the North of the Eisenhower Pier (North) at Bangor Harbour.
- 2. In order to ensure that the Sail Past runs in a timely manner all boats proposing to take part in the Sail Past should be in the muster area by 11:30. A number of RIBs will try and provide participants with guidance and starting times. Guidance will also be provided on CH 37 on the starting sequence.
- 3. The Sail Past gate will close at 13:15 and no further boats should enter the Sail Past route.
- 4. The Sail Past will closely follow the order of the Regatta starts to facilitate the starting sequence for the Regatta. Boats not taking part in the Regatta are included in this list where known. The start of the Sail Past will be signalled by a gun from the Clubhouse and, where possible, boats will be instructed by one of the RIBs when to join, largely following the sequence as per the table below. If a boat misses her start then they should join in as soon as possible and in an orderly manner.
- 5. The organisers would be grateful if boats would sail past in the order indicated.
- 6. The course is shown in the diagram in Annex A.
- 7. Once boats attending the regatta have completed their sail past, they should proceed to the regatta Committee Boat which will be flying an Orange flag.
- 8. Boats not racing and returning to the Marina should follow the red line on the course diagram and take all care to observe the normal COLAS regulations and Bangor Harbour by-laws.
- All participating crews are invited to RUYC at the conclusion of the Sail Past or the Regatta, where they will be presented with a ceremonial plaque to mark the occasion.
